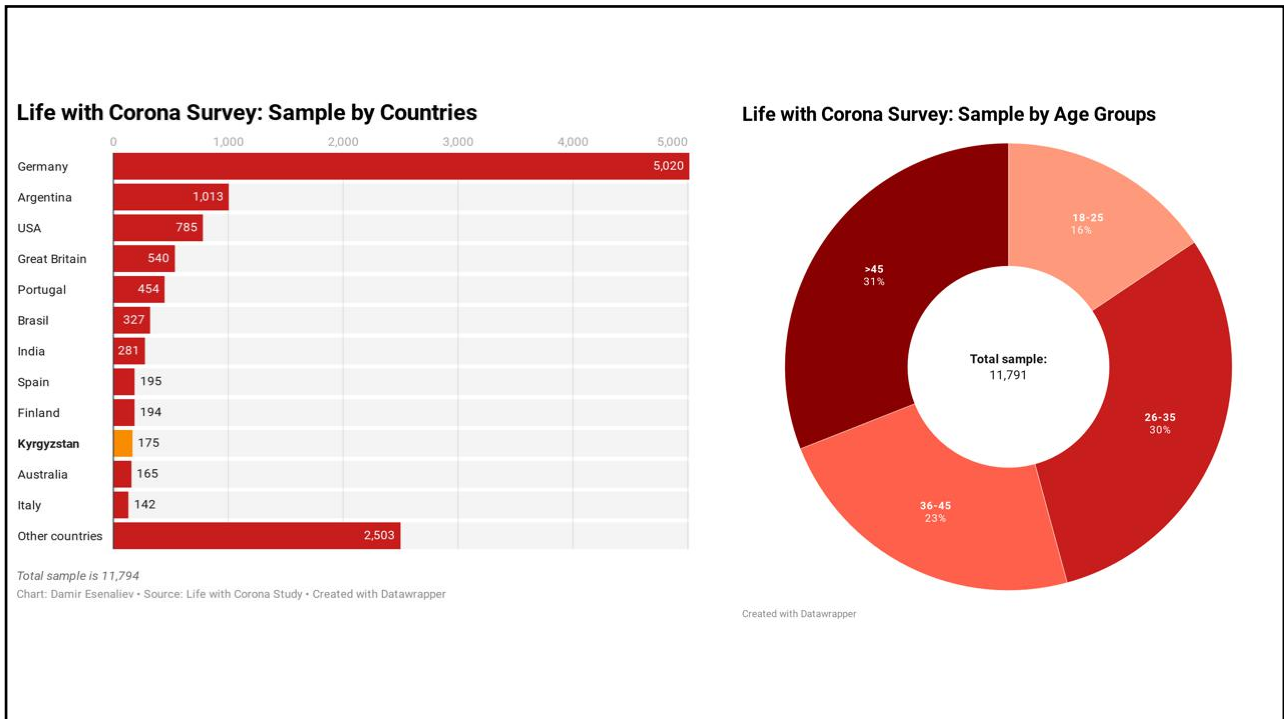

Six Findings from Round 1 of Life with Corona Study

1. Young adults actively perform many behaviours to counter the pandemic
2. Stress on families during the pandemic falls disproportionately on women who live with more than one other person
3. Older people are less stressed than younger people and are less worried about current circumstances
4. After the peak of COVID-related deaths, support for countermeasures drops
5. Around the world, people want global access to a vaccine – only in USA do a larger proportion support special access for their own country
6. Younger people are more willing to pay to stop the spread of the disease than older

Finding 1: Compared to other countries, in Kyrgyzstan people undertake significantly less counter-coronavirus actions

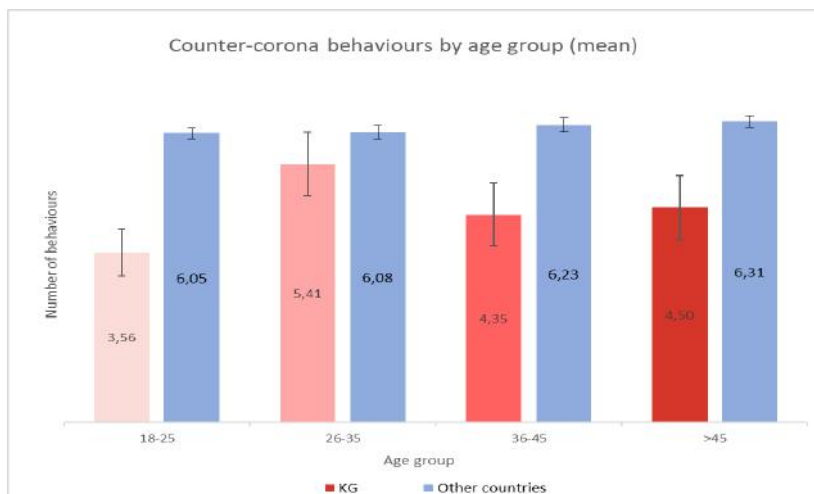
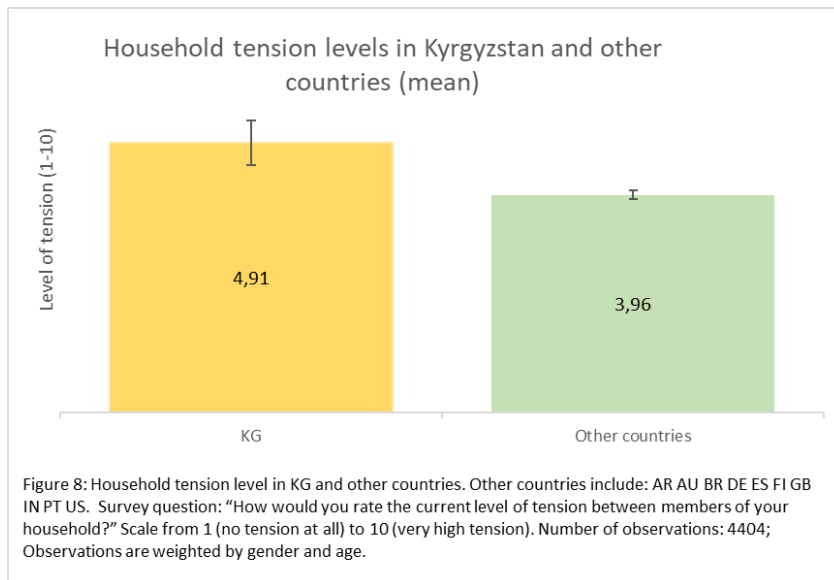


Figure 4: Counter-corona behaviours by age group. Survey question: "Which of the following protective measures have you taken in the past 7 days? (select all that apply)" (min=0, max=9). Other countries include AR AU BR DE ES FI GB IN PT US. Number of observations: 8876; Observations are weighted by gender and age.

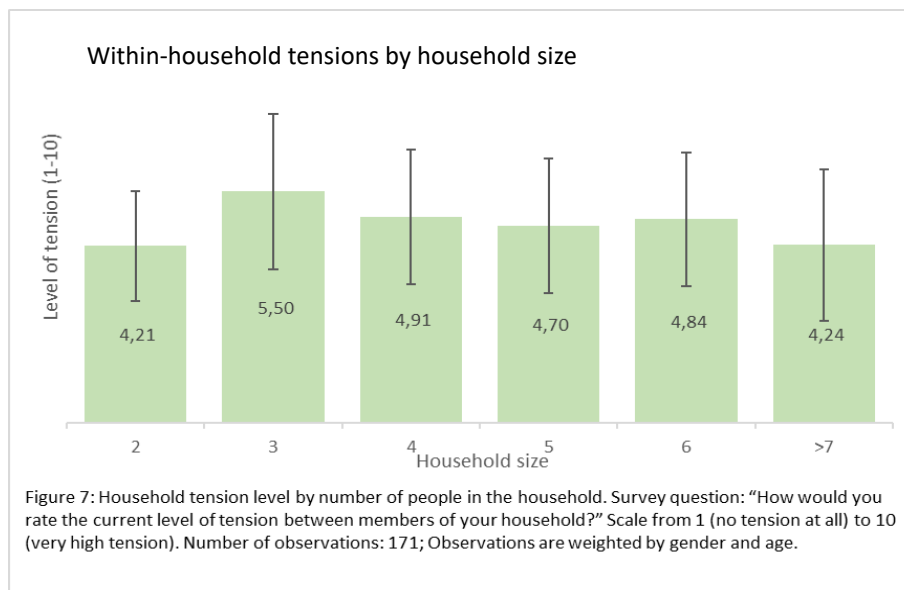

Finding 3: People in Kyrgyzstan are more worried about their health than people in other countries

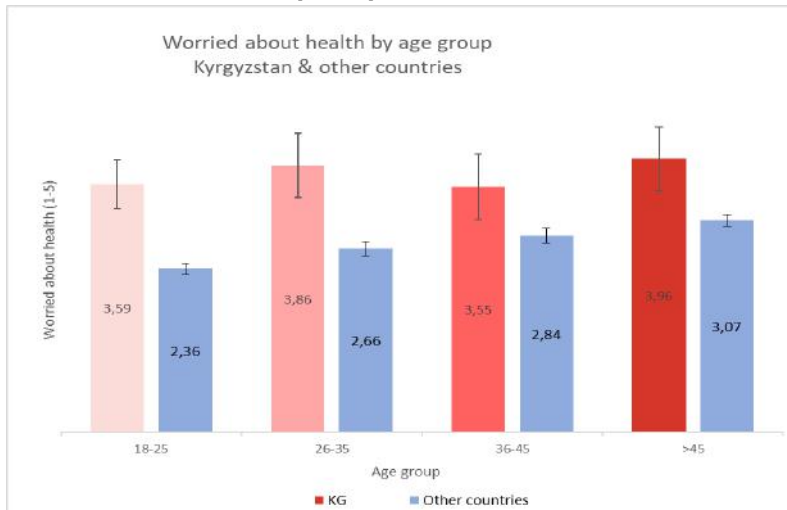


Figure 12: Worried about health by age group KG and other countries. Survey question: "To which extent do the following statements apply to you right now? I am worried about my health". Scale from 1 (does not apply at all) to 5 (strongly applies). Other countries include AR AU BR DE ES FI GB IN PT US. Number of observations: 8932; Observations are weighted by gender and age.

Finding 3: But older people are less stressed, both in Kyrgyzstan and elsewhere

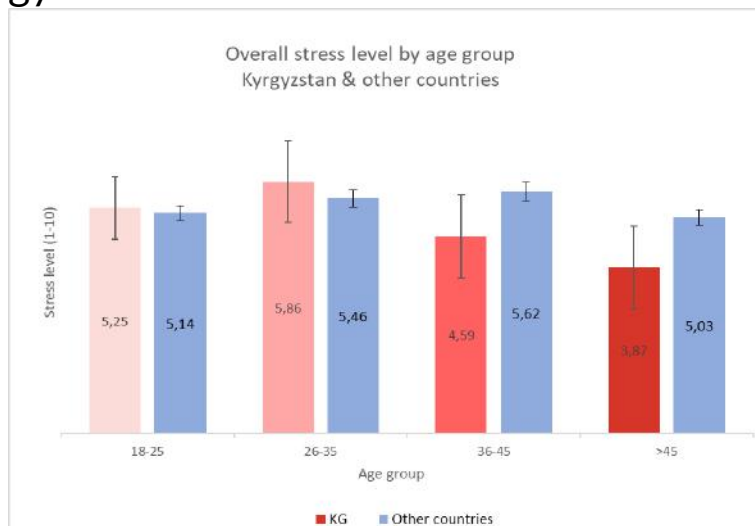


Figure 13: Overall stress level by age group. Survey question: "How would you rate your overall stress level at the moment?" Scale from 1 (I am not stressed at all) to 10 (I am extremely stressed). Other countries include AR AU BR DE ES FI GB IN PT US. Number of observations: 8932; Observations are weighted by gender and age.

Finding 4: Support for countermeasures in Kyrgyzstan is lower than in other countries

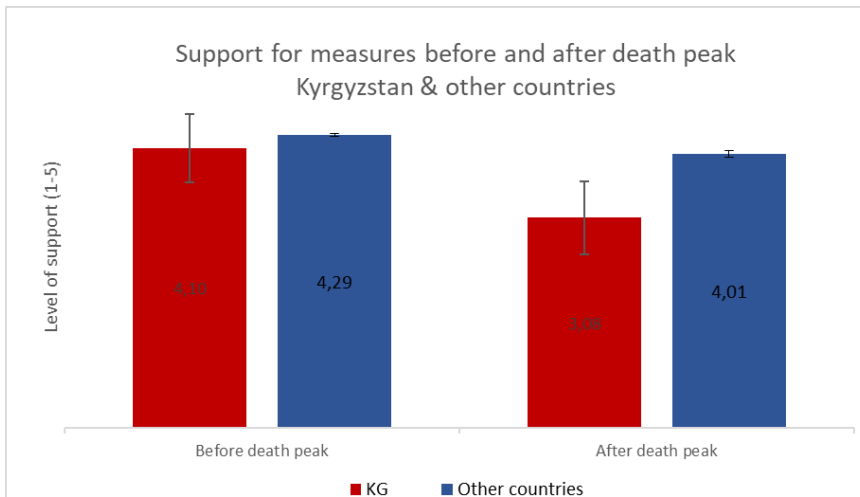


Figure 15: Support for measures before and after death peak KG & other countries. Survey question: "How supportive are you of the measures that the authorities have put in place in response to the corona crisis?" Scale from 1 (Not supportive at all) to 5 (Extremely supportive). Other countries include: AR AU BR DE ES FI GB IN PT US.

Finding 5: In Kyrgyzstan, the majority of people want global access to a vaccine, as elsewhere

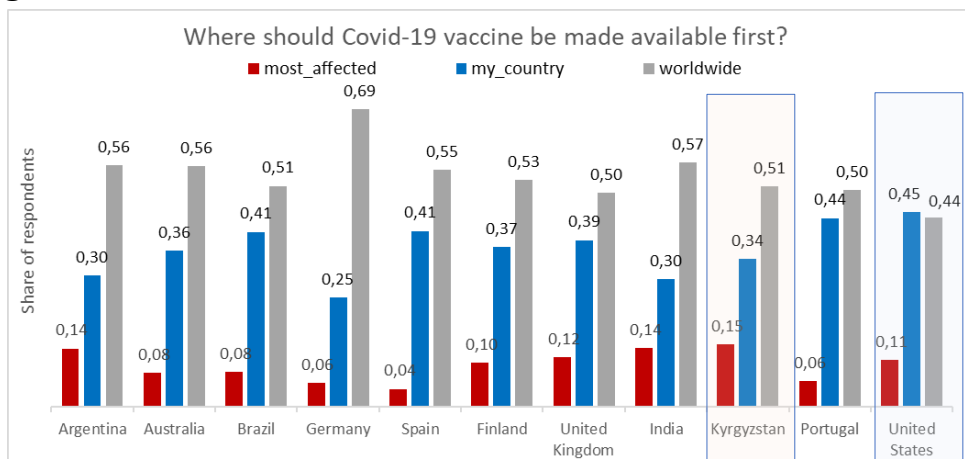
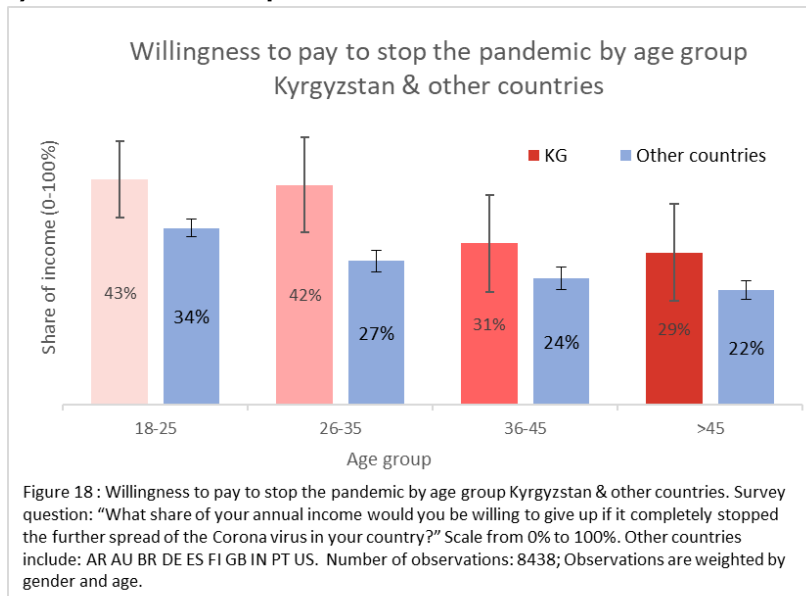


Figure 16: Vaccination priority by country. Survey question: "Imagine a company in your country successfully developed a vaccine against the coronavirus. Please select the statement you agree with most: The vaccine should first be made available in my country, then elsewhere / The vaccine should first be made available in the countries of the world with the highest infection rates, then elsewhere / The vaccine should be made available in all countries at the same time." Number of observations: 8932; Observations are weighted by gender and age.

Finding 6: In fact, younger people in the world are willing to pay more to stop the virus

How Kyrgyzstan compares to other top-responded countries in the Life with Corona Survey?

1. Compared to other countries, in Kyrgyzstan people undertake significantly less counter-coronavirus actions
2. Tension in households is higher in Kyrgyzstan than in other countries surveyed
3. People in Kyrgyzstan are more worried about their health than people in other countries
4. Support for countermeasures in Kyrgyzstan is lower than in other countries
5. In Kyrgyzstan, the majority of people want global access to a vaccine, as elsewhere
6. Younger people in Kyrgyzstan are also willing to pay more to stop the virus
