

- **Public-private** rapprochement





Early Insights from 2023

- Ongoing project @NU:
- 'A Comparative, Interdisciplinary Ethnography on Entrepreneurship in Kazakhstan & Uzbekistan'
- Methodology:

interviews with various 'practitioners'; on-site observations; case studies

- Processual Perspective:

recurring visits & interviews; social media tracking & in-between check-ins

Early Insights from 2023

- 1) Entrepreneurial Motivation
- 'Be your own boss!': risk vs. stasis of government sector
- Beyond profit-seeking: merit, community, work & life
- 2) Challenges
- Corporate vs. local culture? Hierarchy & creativity?
- **Human** capital; **trust** in institutions; beyond **start-up**?
- 3) Value Chains beyond BRI & EEU
- Translocal, e.g. Tashkent, Delaware, Astana
- Government support: training, subsidies, Astana Hub
