Main pillars:


- Diversity


METHODOLOGY


- Fieldwork dates: September 19 - October 10, 2022
- Method: face-to-face CAPI
- Sampling method: probability-based sampling
- **Sample:** 404, 18-65 age from all four districts of Bishkek, permanently residing in the city for the last 3 years.
- Margin of error: 4.9% at 95% CI





In general, are you satisfied or dissatisfied with the state of affairs in Bishkek?



What do you see as the main <u>disadvantages</u> of living in Bishkek?















In your opinion, is it comfortable or uncomfortable for pedestrians/cars/bikes & scooters to move around Bishkek today?






In your opinion, do the Bishkek authorities consider or do not consider the opinions and desires of citizens when making important decisions for the city?




Do you think that today the administration of your district is open to dialogue with the residents of the district or closed?


Increasing utility tariffs to improve the environmental situation

Increasing fares on public transport to improve the public transport situation




How do you assess the environmental situation in Bishkek?




In your opinion, has the environmental situation in Bishkek improved, worsened, or generally remained the same over the past year or two?

Do you think the environmental situation in your neighbourhood is better, worse or about the same compared to the situation in other districts?







What do you think has the greatest negative impact on the environmental situation in your area?




What about the environmental situation in your area worries you most recently?




Do you or your family members have health problems that, in your opinion, began due to the environmental situation in Bishkek?
