



































SDG Country Context: Progress

SDG progress in country:

- High stated political commitment to the SDG targets
- Close collaboration with international development agencies
- Integration of SDG targets into national policy
 - The SDGs have been incorporated into the National Development Strategy for 2018-2040, the National Development Programme for 2021-2026, the Development Programme "Unity. Trust. Creation" for 2018-2022, and the Health Strategy "Healthy person prosperous country" for 2019-2030
 - The RIA findings indicate that the alignment of the SDGs with the national strategic development planning in the Kyrgyz Republic is at 82%

SDG Country Context: Progress

SDG progress in country:


- Significant progress in eliminating extreme poverty (SDG 1) though with reverse of progress in 2021-23, advancing universal health coverage, reducing child mortality (SDG 3), and ensuring inclusive and accessible compulsory education (SDG 4)
- Improvements in life expectancy: 77.31 years (+4.02 years) for females and 70.75 years (+5.55 years) for males
- Implemented universal health coverage and social insurance schemes (MHIF, SGBP)
- Progress in achieving health and health-related SDGs (achieved SDG 3.1)

• In 2022, the statistical performance index was 78.6.

Baseline Review of Literature

- 143 separate search terms used related to HHSDG progress, mental health, climate change, gender inequality, and specific HHSDG targets
- Inclusion criteria: post-2015, directly address the HHSDGs OR specific topics within the health-related SDG framework (air, soil, and water pollution, gender, domestic violence, food security, nutrition, poverty, the health workforce, HIV/TB, specific non-communicable diseases, health financing, health systems, etc.)
- Data search tools: Google Scholar, Research Rabbit, Consensus AI tools for data search allow for a more comprehensive search through scholarly databases, including PubMed and Lens.Org (Research Rabbit) and Semantic Scholar (Consensus).
- Data analysis additional tool: SciSpace an additional AI tool that allows for rapid identification of the content of research papers.
- Search results: 30 (17 included) reports and 112 (108 included) research papers or articles

Key (High-level) Findings

Challenges and bottlenecks:

- Inefficient implementation of policy (lack of coordination between different levels of government and other stakeholders, poor communication strategy, limited engagement of civil society and academia)
- Achieving equity and universal health coverage is significantly limited with notable disparities, high levels of poverty, and weak social assistance systems that fail to adequately support vulnerable populations.
- Health workforce shortages, insufficient quality of medical education, poor retention and preparedness of health workers at the PHC level, limited capacity-building opportunities
- Poor/uneven quality of health services, outdated infrastructure

Key (High-level) Findings

Challenges and bottlenecks:

- High and rising poverty rates
- Persistent funding gap and high out-of-pocket health expenditures (despite MHIF and SGBP)
- Limited integration of HHSDGs into subnational budgeting processes
- Inefficient use of resources (high unnecessary hospitalization rates, lack of preventive measures)
- Regional disparities (urban vs rural, among oblasts)
- High risks of water and energy scarcity

SDGs Kyrgyzstan Context: Climate Change

- High vulnerability to climate change in mountainous regions
- Spillover effects on agriculture, increased vulnerability to drought, and risks to food security and nutrition
- Stated policy priorities give significant focus to climate change and disaster risk reduction, but there is slow progress in implementation
- Limited resilience to climate change and limited adaptation strategies, including planning and funding
- The current progress of the national "green" policy shows a lack of commitment, understanding, management, coordination, and financial resources resulting in poor implementation



SDGs Country Context: Example of Air Pollution


- UNICEF estimated 112 deaths and economic loss of more than \$20 million USD due to exposure to PM2.5
- WHO's guideline of 5 μg/m³





SDGs Country Context: Mental Health

- Retained the characteristics of the previous Soviet system
- Mental health services not prioritized in healthcare reforms
 - Extremely low funding
 - Lack of clear strategy and plans, limited intersectoral collaboration
 - Chronic shortage of human resources
 - No programme evaluation
 - Highly stigmatized
 - Little focus on reducing suicide, tackling substance abuse or on multimorbidities (e.g. mental health disorder linked to NCDs)
 - Remains centred around inpatient hospital care; outpatient care remains under-resourced



SDGs Kyrgyzstan Context: Gender Equity

- High prevalence of gender-based violence (GBV) and intimatepartner violence (IPV)
- Structural and legal barriers in seeking help, including financial dependence on the abuser, stigma, social acceptance, and inadequate enforcement of laws
- Regional disparities: women in rural settings often experience poverty and insufficient access to basic services
- Traditional views contribute to unequal land ownership and control over resources, giving men more decision-making power
- Absence of family planning policies and sex education leads to high rates of abortion, adolescent births, and maternal mortality



SDGs Kyrgyzstan Context: Gender Equity

Gender differences:

- Males prevail in mortality rates, including neonatal and child mortality, and those attributed to noncommunicable diseases, except for diabetes. Males also have higher incidence rates of infectious diseases and substance use.
- Females are more frequently affected by domestic violence, mortality attributed to diabetes, and, recently, HIV incidence.
